

Name: NRA Basic Pistol Shooting Course

Short Description: Teaches the basic knowledge, skills, and attitude for owning and operating a pistol safely.

More Details: This course is at least 8-hours long and includes classroom and range time learning to shoot Revolvers and Semi-automatic pistols. Students learn NRA's rules for safe gun handling, pistol parts and operation, ammunition, shooting fundamentals, range rules, shooting from the bench rest position, and two handed standing positions. Cleaning the pistol; and continued opportunities for skill development. Students will receive the NRA Guide to the Basics of Pistol Shooting handbook, NRA Gun Safety Rules brochure, Winchester/NRA Marksmanship Qualification booklet, and take a Basics of Pistol Shooting Student Examination, and get your course completion certificate. You do not need to own a pistol. There are several available to review and use. If you use our ammo there is a small fee associated.

Friday: Start at 7:00 P.M. till 9:00 P.M.
Drinks are available for a donation.
Pistol and ammo not needed.

Saturday: Start at 08:00 A.M. Pistol and ammo not needed in the morning. Coffee and donuts will be provided. Lunch at around 11:00 A.M. Bring a bag lunch or order pizza. After lunch the range will be set up for shooting.

From route 30E take the route 462 exit. At the light turn right, stay in left lane and go to the next red light. That is Strasburg road, turn left onto Strasburg Road. After crossing the bridge at the Antique Shop make a right at the next intersection onto Windy Hill Road. At the next stop sign turn right into the development. As soon as you turn into the development there is a driveway on your right in between stone pillars that goes behind the houses. Take that driveway to the clubhouse parking lot.

Course Cost: \$85 less a \$20 deposit to hold a seat. Deposit should be returned with application for enrollment in the class.
